Also, thank you to Bob Burstein for keeping us hydrated.




Fishing for Reds in Pretty Lake 4/19/24:

Went fishing with Ned Smith in Pretty Lake looking primarily for puppy drum. We were only anchored about 5 minutes before I had one on. Then Ned and I proceeded to catch one after the other for an hour. We ended up catching 11 puppies: One 27 inch, 2 25 inch, 2 24 inch, 1 21 inch, and 5 under 18 inch. Not sure how many we hooked and they got off. Thy loved the 27 MR MirrOlure, the 18MR and Paul Browns. Water temp was 67 degrees, cloudy all mourning and the water was very clear. One of my 25 inch reds weighed 5lbs, 4oz.

Back again in Pretty Lake 4/23/24:

This time Louis Glaser joined Ned and me looking for the reds again. While the action wasn't as active as last time we still ended up catching 8 reds, the biggest 24 inch and one trout, 19 inch. Again 27 MR and 18 MR MirrOlure prevailed.


Micki caught an 18.25", 2 lb 5 oz Roundhead! She only caught 2 fish this morning but they were both impressive catches!





