










Coast Guard Course 2025





We started catching as soon as we got there. Most were 17-inch fish but were a whole lot of fun fighting them. We ended up with 40+ between us with only 2 slot fish, 18.5-inch and 19-inch fish. All caught on shrimp Gulp.

3/4/25 with Russell: Finally had a calmer day with sun after too many windy ones. We headed to Lake Smith to get a preliminary sense of what the lake could produce for the Tournament on 3/15. The first place we fished produced only 12-inch crappies. Russell got a 12.5-inch, and a 12-inch released. I only got one 12-incher. Moving on to another cove further in the lake was the ticket. Russell released a 14-inch and a 14.5-inch crappie, and I released a 12.25-inch, 13-inch and 13.5-inch crappie and one 15.25-inch bass. Over-all a great day fishing and catching on shiners under bobbers. These gave us Expert status with 6 released each. The fish were still prespawn but turning darker.

3/13/25 with Ronnie: Ronnie Willoughby and I decided to get my boat out on the lake a few days before the Tournament despite it being overcast, windy and cold at 4pm. Water temperature was still 54 degrees, so we hoped to also catch a few as well. We were not disappointed. Ronnie hooked and released a 15.5-inch state citation crappie and a 12.5-inch crappie as I released a 13.5 inch one. This was Ronnie's first citation crappie. Not bad for one hour of fishing. But it was too cold and we weren't dressed for it.




Fresh Water News

3/15/25 VBAC Crappie Tournament with Ronnie: We launched about 8:30am in a misty but calm and cold day at Lake Smith. The first place we fished also had someone there also, but we tried it anyway. No Luck. So, we headed to a place we knew had fish two days before and wow, we hit the jackpot!!! We started catching about 10:45am when the Solunar tables said was the best time and didn't stop catching fish until 3:45pm. We kept 18 crappies between 12 and 13.75 inches. My biggest was 13.75-inch. Ronnie released 4 club minimums giving him the Expert status for crappie. We also released about 5 undersized crappie and two bass. Despite not catching the winner of the Tournament (Melanie did) we couldn't have been happier. Catching one after another in one place was awesome. Actually, a typical spawning day (it was a full month peak) and they all were black as can be.




